



Frequently Asked Questions

When and where is the Sidewalk Arts Festival?

Saturday, September 12 from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m. We are pleased to offer a special hour of shopping from 8-9 a.m. dedicated for high-risk festival attendees. The festival takes place in downtown Sioux Falls on Main and Dakota Avenues from 10th to 13th Street, 11th Street from Minnesota Avenue to Main Avenue and in the parking lots just south of the Washington Pavilion.

What health and safety measures will be in place for the festival?

- Multiple entrances and exits are available throughout the festival.
- There will be directional signage to help create a safer traffic flow throughout the festival.
- We will have multiple hand sanitizer stations available.
- All participants and attendees are encouraged to follow these safety measures: physical distancing, wearing face masks and using the provided hand sanitizer.

Are face masks required?

Festival vendors and attendees are strongly encouraged to wear face masks. Face masks are required for festival staff and volunteers.

Where can I park?

- *Please DO NOT park in private parking lots or on Phillips Avenue
- On side streets (except by meters with "No Parking" signs on them)
 - In city parking ramps at these locations: (FREE on weekends!)
 - 12th Street (south side) and Main Avenue
 - 13th Street and Main Avenue
 - 10th and Main Avenue
 - 10th Street and 1st Avenue
 - 11th Street and 1st Avenue
 - 13th Street and Dakota – Parking Lot
- In the Davenport Evans parking lot (14th & Dakota)

Is there stuff for kids to do at the festival?

You bet! There will be lots of fun activities in the Children's Studio, located on the north side of the Pavilion in the Paladino Hohm Sculpture Garden.

Can I bring my pet to the festival?

We discourage bringing pets to the festival because of the number of people at the festival. Please leave pets at home.

Where can I find the Information Booth and the First Aid Station?

Information can be found at the southwest corner of 11th and Main at the Pavilion's booth. Lost children can find help here. Lost and Found is also located at this booth. First Aid will be available in the Pavilion's loading dock at 11th and Dakota.

Where can I get a festival map?

Festival maps will be available at the Information Booth (11th and Main), or you may download one from the [website](#).

Will there be live entertainment at the festival?

Yes! Several talented individuals and groups will perform throughout the day in the Paladino Hohm Sculpture Garden.

Is there an ATM available at the festival?

Yes. There is an ATM on the 1st level of the Great Western Bank parking ramp. There is also an ATM located inside the Washington Pavilion, right across from the Box Office.

Where can I find public restrooms at the festival?

- On Main Avenue, near the Great Western Bank driveway
- At the intersection of 11th Street and Minnesota Avenue
- At the intersection of 11th Street and Dakota Avenue
- At the intersection of 12th Street and Dakota Avenue
- Inside the Washington Pavilion

What sort of vendors will be there?

There is a wonderful selection of fine artists, crafters, food vendors and non-profit organizations ready to wow you with their handiworks, satisfy your appetites and share their passions. From ceramics and hand-painted signs to fresh lemonade and funnel cakes, there's certainly something for everyone!
